

**CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE
ORDINANCE NO.: 2000-435**

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE ALL SHIPYARD, MARINE CONTRACTORS AND ANY OTHER BUSINESS ENTITY THAT UTILIZES OR CONDUCTS BUSINESS OPERATIONS WHICH UTILIZE THE WATERWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE TO HAVE VALID ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY OR ADEM PERMITS PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF ANNUAL BUSINESS LICENSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE,

ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the **CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE CITY COUNCIL**, in the interest of public safety and environmental concerns desires to regulate those businesses that conduct ship building, repairs, sandblasting, painting or other functions incident to ship building or repair activities or drainage accessible to waterways on or along the waterways within the City of Bayou La Batre to comply with all federal and state regulations and

WHEREAS, the **CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE CITY COUNCIL** believes it to be in the best interest of the City and for the public good that all business operations along said waterways have valid federal and/or state permits as a prerequisite to the issuance of a City of Bayou La Batre business license.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE CITY COUNCIL would show as follows:

SECTION ONE: That any and all shipyards, marine or other repair facilities, including but not limited to, ship building, shipyard repairs, mechanical repairs, sandblasting and/or painting operations that operate on or adjacent to any waterway within the City of Bayou La Batre shall be required to exhibit and produce to the City Clerk valid permit(s) from the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) and/or Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) permit or those businesses that are required to comply with federal (NPDES) storm water regulations to have such valid permit at the time of issuance by the City of Bayou La Batre of an annual business license.
