CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE ORDINANCE NO.: 2001-439

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 361 WHICH PROVIDES FOR BUILDING AND OTHER STANDARD CODES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF STANDARD CODES.

The National Fire Protection Association's 1994 edition of the National Electrical Code, together with all amendments thereto, and the following standard codes issued by Southern Building Code Congress International, Inc., together with all amendments to any of same, copies of all of which said codes have been on file in the office of the City Clerk, are hereby amended as follows:

ELECTRICAL CODE:

(a) National Fire Protection Association's 1999 National Electrical Code

BUILDING CODE: FROM SOUTHERN BUILDING CODE CONGRESS INTERNATIONAL, INC.

- (a) 1999 Standard Building Code
- (b) 1997 Standard Existing Building Code
- (c) 1999 Standard Fire Prevention Code
- (d) 1997 Standard Housing Code
- (e) 1997 Standard Mechanical Code
- (f) 1999 Standard Swimming Pool Code
- (g) Standard Code Interpretations (1992 edition).

SECTION 2. AREAS SUBJECT TO ORDINANCE.

Unless specifically stated otherwise or where the context clearly indicates otherwise or requires a different meaning, each provision of this Ordinance shall apply to all areas within the corporate limits of the City of Bayou La Batre.

SECTION 3. PENALTIES.

Any person found guilty of violating any provision of any of the codes adopted in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period of not exceeding six (6) months, or both.

SECTION 4. REPEAL OF ORDINANCE.

Ordinance No. 361 and any other part(s) of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, and all standard codes or parts of standard codes heretofore adopted by the City that are in conflict with any of the codes adopted herein, are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on of after the ____ day of February, 2001, and from year to year thereafter until repealed.
