

**CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE
ORDINANCE NO.: 2001-445**

**AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE NO PARKING ZONES ON CERTAIN CITY
STREETS**

WHEREAS, the **CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE** deems it in the interest of public safety and for the benefit of the citizenry of the City that portions of certain city streets more particularly described herein, on which parking has been heretofore permissible, be deemed "no parking" zones; and

WHEREAS, the **CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE** desires to establish an enforcement mechanism by which to deter and punish violations of such prohibitions against parking on said city streets; and

WHEREAS, the **CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE** has previously adopted and approved Ordinance Number 1995-375 entitled **AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW CERTAIN CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE ORDINANCES TO BE ENFORCED BY ISSUANCE OF A MUNICIPAL OFFENSE TICKET; SCHEDULE OF FINES; AUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN CITY EMPLOYEES TO ISSUE A MUNICIPAL OFFENSE TICKET.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: PARKING PROHIBITED

That it shall be unlawful to park a vehicle upon the hereinafter described sections and right of ways of the following City streets:

- (A) Harding Avenue: between Hemley Road and East Rabby Street
- (B) Sprinkle Avenue: South of Hemley Road to East Rabby Street
- (C) Mars Avenue: North of Hemley Road to the end of Mars Avenue

as that the same are hereby declared "No Parking" zones.

SECTION TWO: MUNICIPAL OFFENSE TICKET

That the owner, driver or person in control or possession of a vehicle parked in violation of Section One shall be issued a Municipal Offense Ticket pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance Number 1995-375, which is hereby incorporated by reference in its entirety.

SECTION THREE: PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

That any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine payable as a scheduled fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) plus court costs without a court appearance and payable pursuant to the provisions so established in Ordinance 1997-375..

SECTION FOUR: REPEAL OF CONFLICTING CODE SECTIONS AND ORDINANCES

All City of Bayou La Batre Ordinances, including any penalty provisions, in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance, insofar as they conflict.

SECTION FIVE: SEVERABILITY

If any article, section, sentence, clause or phrase in this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by declaration of any Court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION SIX: EFFECT OF ORDINANCE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law. This Ordinance applies to property within the City limits and police jurisdictions of the City of Bayou La Batre, Alabama and shall be in force and effect therein.
