ORDINANCE NO.: 2003-487

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**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL VENDOR'S WHO CONDUCT
WORK FOR THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE TO BE
APPROPRIATELY LICENSED AND INSURED**

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WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bayou La Batre believes it to be in the best interest of the City to require that all vendor's who conduct business for the City of Bayou La Batre to be properly licensed, and to obtain the necessary insurance and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bayou La Batre, in order to promote the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the City of Bayou La Batre requires that all vendor's who conduct business for the City of Bayou La Batre to be properly licensed and to obtain the necessary insurance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE, ALABAMA as follows:

SECTION ONE: VENDOR REQUIREMENTS FOR WORK DONE ON ANY AND ALL CITY OWNED PROPERTIES

All vendor's who conduct business for the City of Bayou La Batre shall be required to purchase a current year City of Bayou La Batre business license. All vendor's who employ others to conduct business for the City of Bayou La Batre shall obtain worker's compensation insurance. Additionally, all general contractors conducting business for the City of Bayou La Batre shall maintain a current year general contractors license and shall obtain a performance bond for all work conducted for the City of Bayou La Batre. Amount of performance bond to be determined by City of Bayou La Batre Building Inspector.

SECTION TWO: PENALTY

Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be

punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars and No/100 (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or both, at the discretion of the Municipal Judge.

SECTION THREE: REPEALER

All other City Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, insofar as they conflict, are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. Any provision, section, paragraph, sentence or part thereof shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not effect or impair the remainder of the Ordinance, it being the legislative intent to ordain and enact each provision, section, paragraph, sentence and part thereof separately and independently of each other.

SECTION FIVE: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force from and after the date of its approval and adoption by the City Council by the City of Bayou La Batre and publication is required by law.
